
New Life Kids Church happens after worship

Missions Trip To Colima, Mexico

Nov. 24—Dec. 1, 2017

Minister alongside our New Life Missionaries bringing encouragement and the love of Christ to the people of Colima and those who support them on a daily basis.

There will be various opportunities for ministry in schools, group homes, churches and small maintenance or building projects.

To support the widows and orphan projects, volunteers would go in on the short term and assist in the following ways:

- Maintenance work, cleaning, or painting;
- Spend time with the children: playing, swimming, doing crafts, and/or teaching them English.
- Construction - repairing or replacing roofs in the community, building, and/or laying bricks for houses, pouring concrete, tiling floors, painting etc;
- Assist with teaching English in the Christian school with children in groups and one on one.
- Evangelizing – in conjunction with people from the local church
- Medical/Dental Outreach – this would require a team of professionals to work with local professionals to do an outreach in the community.

Total cost: \$1350/per person

Includes Return flights from Kelowna and transfers to Colima

Food: Accommodation includes lunches: Kitchen available to make our own food or order out.
